Dangerous Dog Requirements (Permit Length 2 Years Mandatory)

7-1A-16: - "Dangerous" Animals Prohibited.

B. Conditions for Keeping an Animal Classified as "Dangerous".

1. The owner of the classified animal shall comply with all of the following conditions:

- i. The owner shall immediately notify the City Manager or designee in the event that the "Dangerous" animal is loose, stolen, at large, unconfined, has mauled, bitten, attacked, threatened, or in any way menaced another domesticated animal or human. The owner shall also notify the City Manager or designee in the event the "Dangerous" animal is sold, disposed of, or has died.
- j. Failure to comply with any of these conditions may result in the impoundment of the animal, subject to disposition pursuant to 7-1A-16, Section F, EMC.

Guard Dog Requirement (Permit Valid for 1 year from Date of Approval)

7-1A-16: - "Dangerous" Animals Prohibited (Guard Dogs are Considered Dangerous Animals).

Honeybee Permit Requirements (Permit Valid for 5 years)

Those applying for a zoological permit as a beekeeper shall adhere to appropriate beekeeping practices including:

- o Maintain bee colonies in movable-frame hives kept in sound and usable condition
- o Provide a constant and adequate water source
- o Locate hive(s) so that the movement of bees does not become an animal nuisance (City of Englewood Municipal Ordinance 15-11-1: Animals or Fowl)
- o Provide contact information for immediate response to remediate nuisance conditions and control bee swarms

Zoological Permit Requirements (Permit Valid for 5 years) (Venomous Snakes are not allowed)

All animals must be housed in appropriate cages / habitats and have access to water and appropriate food.

All animals must be cleaned and inspected daily.

Owner shall immediately notify Animal Control of any escape from the premise or bite on a person

RV Transit Permit Requirements: (Permit Valid for a Maximum of 7 Days)

Vehicle must be currently registered and insured.

Permit must be displayed on front windshield or door visible from the outside.

Vehicle must be parked in a way to not block or cause an obstruction.

Vehicle may be requested to move at any time due to weather, road work, or other emergency situation.

Vehicle must be fully contained to include water, sewer and electric. The sidewalk shall not be obstructed.

Cat Trapping Requirements (Permit Valid for a Maximum of 7 Days)

- You are responsible for transporting captured cats to the Humane Society of the South Platte Valley, 2129 W. Chenango Ave., Littleton, CO., 80120, phone- (303)703-2938 fax (303)703-2922 and is open Monday- Saturday-11 a.m.- 6 p.m. and Sunday-12 p.m.- 5 p.m.
- Bait the trap with canned cat food or tuna. Fishy, smelly foods work best
- You may not kill, torture, tease or molest a trapped animal. Do not stick fingers or hands into the trap as the animal may bite.
- Do not set the trap if you are not going to be able to monitor it at least every 8 hours. If bad weather is expected ensure the trap is set in a sheltered area.
- Cats trapped after shelter hours must be moved to a sheltered area to protect them from the elements. Cover the trap with a towel or rug to help keep the cat calm.
